Former parishioner to give talk on Pope Francis' *Laudato Si*
Mark Graham, Ph.D. (Boston College) is parishioner Laurie Graham's son. He is Associate Professor of Theological Ethics and the Director of the Undergraduate Program in the Theology and Religious Studies Department at Villanova University. He has published two books, *Josef Fuchs on Natural Law* (Georgetown University Press, 2002) and *Sustainable Agriculture: A Christian Ethic of Gratitude* (Pilgrim Press, 2005), in addition to a number of academic articles in the field of Christian Ethics. He is the father of two sassy teenagers, Pete (16) and Hannah (15), and he currently spends most of his scholarly energy researching and writing in the area of Christian environmental ethics. The title of the talk is "**Pope Francis' *Laudato Si*: The Promise and Peril of Catholic Environmentalism.**" It will be held **Wed, June 27 at 7 pm.**
