Enrollment

Saint Thomas Aquinas School is open to all students and faiths pre-school through sixth grade. A percentage of our enrollment is made up of students of other faiths.

Tuition

Tuition is set each year by the Board of Education. Please call at any time for current tuition rates. Tuition grants are available. The St. Thomas Aquinas Foundation provides grants for Catholics who have a need. The Archdiocese of Dubuque Our Faith, Our Children, Our Future School Tuition Organization (STO) is available for all students, regardless of faith. This STO is a charitable organization that receives voluntary cash contributions from Iowa taxpayers and allocates those funds in tuition grants to Iowa school children, who in turn use those grants to attend an accredited, nonpublic school represented by the STO.
